Grape varieties : 100 % Cinsault

Type of soils : sandstone, granit

Climate : fresh, under the sea breezes - altitude of 300m

Historical terroirs - Approx. 1900 ha which makes it the 10th grape variety in the country.

It is found in particular in Paarl, Bredekloof and in the Malmesbury area in Swartland.

Type of soil : sandstone and granite

Climate : cool climate due to sea breezes / altitude of 300m

Planting of vines in South Africa since 1659.

Boom in viticulture and especially Sauvignon in 1990 with the release of Nelson Mandela and the end of the boycott of South African products.
